# ABBNEY HILL GOLF CLUB



Situated just off the A5 on the outskirts of Milton Keynes, Abbey Hill Golf Centre is easily accessible and provides great quality golf and catering facilities with friendly welcoming service. With a choice of the 18 hole Main Course and the Academy Par 3 course, driving range, golf shop, recently refurbished clubhouse, and bright modern function room.

*Originally constructed in 1970, 6023 yards in length, Abbey Hill is a very pleasant parkland course, laid out in loops of eight and ten holes. Enhancements by Howard Swann were completed in 1996 which significantly improved the course by providing eleven new tees, six new greens and brought into play a number of water hazards. The terrain is undulating with mature trees and some spectacular backdrops. A particular feature is the Par 3 17th, which requires a carry over water.*

*Today Abbey Hill is a mature, challenging test of golf, which appeals to both the novice player and to the competitive low handicap player. The greens are fast and true whilst the fairways are lush and manicured. Abbey Hill's Main Course has truly earned its reputation as being the best course in Milton Keynes.*

## **Dress code**

Visitors to Abbey Hill Golf Club are respectfully asked to abide by the club's dress code. Although there is no jacket-and-tie policy, guests are required to be neatly and presentably dressed on the course and in any part of the clubhouse. Smart casual attire is acceptable.

For your guidance, the following items are prohibited:

- Jeans and denims, T-shirts and vests, non-tailored shorts, football/rugby shirts, track suits or shell suits.
- Training shoes in the clubhouse, and all shoes other than golf shoes on the course.
- In the clubhouse:
  - Shoes and waterproof clothing worn on the golf course
  - Headgear
