Dress code

Visitors to Windermere Golf Club are respectfully asked to abide by the club's dress code. Although there is no jacket-and-tie policy, guests are required to be neatly and presentably dressed on the course and in any part of the clubhouse. Smart casual attire is acceptable.

For your guidance, the following items are prohibited:
